Fund raising events November 2017

On Friday 17 November Ernulf Academy will be supporting the Children in Need appeal. We will be holding a non-uniform day.. This year Ernulf Academy is also supporting the Tearfund Toilet Twinning project. This project aims to forge links with communities in Africa by funding the construction of new toilet facilities in areas without adequate sanitation. Each form will be encouraged to raise enough money to fund at least one new toilet. Details of this project have been given to the students during assemblies this week.

The monies raised by the non-uniform day will be split equally between Children in Need and the Toilet Twinning project.
