Dear Parent/Carer

Year 8 trip to the Jewish Museum London – Tuesday 13 June 2017.

This term, Year 8 have been looking at Judaism with the aim of understanding beliefs and practices of Jewish people. They will then be moving on to look at the treatment of the Jews during the Holocaust. As such we have arranged a trip to the Jewish Museum in London. Students will be able to explore Judaism and the Holocaust and have the opportunity to hear an eyewitness account of events, which will soon be beyond living memory.

We will be travelling to London by train and tube. Students will meet at St Neots Train Station at approximately 9am and will return at 4pm, arrangements will need to be made for your child to travel home from the train station. Confirmation of travel arrangements will be provided nearer the time. A vegetarian packed lunch will be required on the day due to the venue we are visiting.

Places for this trip will be on a first come first serve basis as there are a limited number of places due to transport constraints. The cost of the trip will be £25. If your son/daughter is eligible for Pupil Premium funding you will be able to access financial support for this purchase. Pupil premium funding is available for students who have been eligible for free school meals in the last 6 years, are looked after or have parents in the armed forces. Further advice on eligibility for Pupil Premium funding is available on our website. If you are not eligible for Pupil Premium but are currently experiencing financial hardship; the Academy may be able to support you. To secure your child's place on the trip payment can be made through the school parent pay system by Monday 17 April 2017, please do not bring cash or cheques into school.
