We are seeking to appoint a level 1A Teaching Assistant at Ernulf Academy to start as soon as possible. The successful candidate will have initiative, enthusiasm and patience.

In January 2015 Ernulf Academy opened a new facility called 'The Cabin' to support the learning and progress of students with high functioning Asperger syndrome. The Cabin provides a safe place where students can be nurtured and feel secure and free from anxiety. We provide a high quality educational experience that will support their success across a broad and exciting curriculum. We support the students' aspirations for success ensuring that students are challenged in all aspects of their learning experience at Ernulf Academy.

The successful candidate will work under the direction of the teacher in charge of the Cabin to support student progress and to support the classroom teacher to facilitate the active participation of children with Asperger syndrome in the academic and social activities of the school. They may be assigned to support an individual student with Asperger syndrome who may also have additional complex needs. The successful candidate may also be called upon to work with other students across the school.

Applicants should be proactive and have the ability to work using their own initiative. Experience of working with people on the autism spectrum would be an advantage for this post.

The hours of work are 27.5 hours per week, term time only, with an unpaid 20 minute mid-morning break and 40 minute lunch break. Salary scale 1 £13,871 – £14,338, pro rata (actual £9,880 - £10,116).
