Mr David – Head of Year 11, KS4 Director

He is keen to get to know students and parents as quickly as possible. He will be leading the Final Furlong Evening. Ms Williamson will be working on other responsibilities across the Academy.

Final Furlong Evening – Wednesday 9 November “The next six months and Post 16 Options”
