Dear Parent or Carer

As I am sure you are aware, the GCSE examinations are approaching with alarming speed. As a result of the students' hard work, we are on course for another hugely successful year, very possibly the best set of results that Ernulf students have ever secured. As we are now in the final push before the summer examinations, I wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of the support we are offering Year 11 to help them prepare.

We are continuing with our period 6 lessons (revision sessions) after school during the week, as well as some lunchtime sessions. The after school sessions normally run from 3.15pm until 4.15pm. The rooms will vary and students should see the Head of Department if there is any uncertainty.

We shall also be running a number of revision sessions in the Easter holidays which your son/daughter should already be aware of. These sessions will be free of charge and specifically designed to maximise students' marks in their examinations. Although some sessions will be for specific students, all other sessions are open to all students taking that subject. We are also able to offer an open revision session this year where students can come and revise or complete work for any subject with staff supervising. This will be in the second week in the mornings only.

If any student is staying for the whole day, he/she must ensure they have a lunch with them unless alternative arrangements are in place.

The examinations start in May for year 11 this year so there is not a lot of time after the Easter break. All Students should now have their exams timetable and be aware of any outstanding course work they may need to complete by the subject coursework deadline. Please support the Academy in our quest to assist our students to be well prepared in the coming months.

We are aware that this time can be very stressful for both students and parents alike and we shall endeavour to support the students in as many ways as possible. If you have concerns about the preparations for the examinations, please contact your son or daughter's tutor in the first instance or contact myself to discuss any issues relating to your child's preparation for their exams.
